

PETITE SIRAH



In classic varietal style, Luna's 2016 Petite Sirah is busting at the seams with tannins and wild berry flavors.

Despite the name, the grape clusters of Petite Sirah are the largest we see during harvest. The hue of the grape skins is so dark that they are nearly jet black. Grape skins impart much of the tannins in wine, and the Petite Sirah gives a structure and depth that is a real pleasure for those who are not faint of heart for big red wines.

The 2016 Petite Sirah can be aged for ten years to allow the tannins to soften to velvet, or drinkable now for an intense experience.
