In classic varietal style, Luna's 2017 Petite Sirah is bursting at the seams with wild blueberry notes and succulent tannins. Despite the name, the grape clusters of Petite Sirah are the largest we see during harvest and their color is nearly jet black.

These powerfully pigmented grapes, produce dark, inky colored wines with a firm structure and lingering mouth feel. This wine is a real pleasure for those who are not faint of heart for big red wines.

The 2017 Petite Sirah can be aged for ten years to allow the tannins to soften or drinkable now for an intense experience.

Bursting with bright & complex berry flavors. Blueberry, boysenberry and raspberry! Savory, umami notes linger in the background. Bold fruit follows through on the palate with strong chocolate & espresso tannins on the finish.
